Is cúis áthais dom é tréaslú a dhéanamh le Gaisce arís as ar éirigh leo a bhaint amach in 2010. Ba mhór an phléisiúir é a bheith rannpháirteach i líon mór ceiliúrthaí agus cúig bliana fichead ó bunaíodh Gaisce á chomóradh.

Le fiche cúig bliana anuas, is cinnte gur bhain Gaisce an fhís amach a bhí ag a bhunaitheoir, an Dr. Pádraig Ó hIghile. D'imigh na Gradaim ó neart go neart agus tá a n-áit féin acu i samhlaíocht glúin iomlán daoine óga. D'fhéadfaí líon na rannpháirtithe a bhí i gceist a chomhaireamh, líon na mbonn a bronnadh agus líon na searmanas a reáchtáladh le fiche cúig bliana anuas. Ach ní léireodh sé seo ach cuid den rath a bhí air. Bheadh sé i bhfad níos deacra comhaireamh a dhéanamh i bhfigiúirí ar an tionchar a d'fhéadfadh a bheith ag Gradam Gaisce ar shaol duine óg. Gach bliain cuirtear ina luí orm go mór leibhéal na ndúshlán a gcuireann daoine óga rompu agus cuirtear ina luí orm níos mó an chaoi ina n-éiríonn leo na dúshlán seo a bhaint amach. Níl a leithéid ann agus taithí tipiciúil Gaisce – tagann na rannpháirtithe ó réimse leathan de chúlraí éagsúla agus ní chuireann ach a gcuid samhlaíochta srian ar na roghanna a dhéanann siad maidir le tascanna Gaisce. Mar sin féin, tá fuinneamh, díograis agus féinmhuinín ar leith a chomhaontaíonn na daoine óga a mbronnar gradaim orthu agus a mbuailim leo gach bliain agus gabhaim buíochas leis na rannpháirtithe, Ceannairí Ghradam an Uachtaráin agus an fhoireann uile in Gaisce don obair chrua a dhéanann siad.

In 2010, chomh maith le buaileadh leis na daoine óga iontacha a fuair Gradaim Óir Gaisce ba mhór an phléisiúir dom freisin Gradaim Fiúntais Gaisce a bhronnadh agus boinn tionscnaimh an Dr. Phádraig Uí Ighile. Leis na gradaim seo ceiliúrtar tiomantas agus díograis Cheannairí Ghradam an Uachtaráin a chaith cúig bliana ar a laghad le Gaisce, agus bronnadh boinn Uí Ighile ar dhaoine a chaith bliain fichead le Gaisce nó ar dhaoine a rinne ionchur ar leith do Gaisce. Is fiú go mór é go ndéantar comóradh ar na PALanna a rinne ionchur mór agus ar líon éagsúla na ndaoine óga sa bhealach seo agus is cúis áthais í ceiliúradh a dhéanamh leo.

Agus mé anois sa bhliain deiridh mar Uachtarán, ba mhaith liom an deis seo a ghlacadh agus buíochas a ghabháil le Comhairle Gaisce, leis an bhfoireann agus le gach duine a bhí rannpháirteach as an obair a rinne siad chun an méid sin daoine óga a spreagadh agus a threorú agus iad ag dul ar an turas suaithinseach d'fhéinfhionnachtain. Is mór an onóir dom tuarascáil Bhliantúil Gaisce – Gradam an Uachtaráin – 2010 a chur faoi do bhráid. Bliain shuntasach a bhí ann do Gaisce in 2010 inar baineadh mórghníomartha amach, agus na nithe seo a leanas ina measc:

- Stampa comórtha a chuir An Post ar fáil agus clúdach an chéad lae ina raibh beannacht ón Uachtarán Mhic Ghiolla Íosa ar Gaisce agus iad ag ceiliúradh a lubhaile Cúig Bliana Fichead.
- Lainseáil Gobhanóir Bhanc Ceannais na hÉireann, An tOllamh Patrick Honohan €20 de bhoinn óir agus €10 de bhoinn airgid chun ár nLubhaile Cúig Bliana Fichead a chomóradh.
- Fóram Comhaltaí Comhairleacha ina raibh an deis ag Comhairle agus Feidhmeannas Gaisce chun athbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar ár n-aidhmeanna le chéile agus ar an mbealach is fearr chun iad a bhaint amach.
- Áistríodh ár gceanncheathrú ó Chaisleán Bhaile Átha Cliath go Teach Ráth an tSratha i bPáirc an Fhionnuisce. Rinneadh é seo go han-éifeachtach agus táimid fíorbhuíoch d'Oifig na nOibreacha Poiblí as an gcúnamh luachmhar a thug siad dúinn chun é seo a dhéanamh.
- Leanaimid ar aghaidh ag neartú an chaidrimh le heagraíochtaí a bhfuil baint acu lenár ndaoine óga ionas gur féidir linn an Gradam a leathnú amach le go mbeidh fáil níos fairsinge air agus go háirithe dóibh siúd a bhainfeadh an tairbh is mó as.
- Rinneamar Clár Taighde tábhachtach a choimisiúnú le Niamh Clarke McMahon i gcomhar le Dámh na Síceolaíochta in Ollscoil na hÉireann, Baile Átha Cliath ar an éifeacht dhearfach síceolaíochta atá ag Gaisce ar a rannpháirtithe. Ba chóir go mbeadh torthaí an Taighde seo ar fáil go luath in 2013. Táimid ag súil go mbeidh sé seo mar phríomhthionchar ar an gclár amach anseo.
- Tá an bhaint atá againn le Cumann Idirnáisiúnta na nGradam den *Duke of Edinburgh* fós mar thairbhe mór dúinn. Tá an Gradam ar fáil anois in 129 tír ar fud an domhain.

Tá achoimre ar ár Ráitis Airgeadais do 2010 mar a ndearna PricewaterhouseCoopers iniúchadh orthu leagtha amach ar leathanaigh 27 agus 28. An t-ioncam iomlán don bhliain ba ea €1,097,656, laghdú €22,391 ó

## Chairman's Introduction

I am very pleased to introduce the 2010 Annual report of Gaisce – The President's Award. The year 2010 has been a significant year for Gaisce and one of considerable achievements, amongst which I would list the following:

- The production by An Post of a commemorative stamp and first day cover with a greeting from President McAleese to Gaisce on its Silver Jubilee.
- The launching by the Governor of the Central Bank, Professor Patrick Honohan of €20 gold and €10 silver coins to mark our Silver Jubilee.
- The holding of an Advisory Members Forum at which the Council and Executive of Gaisce had the opportunity to review with them our objectives and how we can better achieve them.
- The transfer of our headquarters from Dublin Castle to Ratra House in the Phoenix Park. This was achieved in a very efficient manner and we are indebted to the Office of Public Works for their invaluable assistance in facilitating this.
- We continue to build our relationships with organisations involved with our youth so that we can spread access to the Award more widely and in particular for those who would benefit most from it.
- We have commissioned an important Research Programme with Niamh Clarke McMahon in association with the Faculty of Psychology at University College Dublin on the positive psychological effect which Gaisce has on its participants. The results of this Research should be available in early 2013. This we expect will be a key influence on the programme in future years.
- Our involvement with the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Association continues to be of significant benefit to us. The Award is now available in 129 countries worldwide.

A summary of our Financial Statements for 2010 as audited by PricewaterhouseCoopers is set out on pages 27 and 28. Our total income for the year amounted to €1,097,656, a reduction of €22,391 on 2009. Income from Advisory Members fell by €39,500. In the current very difficult economic circumstances, the Government had been forced to

Chun na laghduithe seo a fhritháireamh bhí orainn an táille rannpháirtíochta a ardú don chéad uair in aon bhliain déag. An caiteachas iomlán don bhliain ba ea €1,090,839 ardú €16,128 ón mbliain roimhe sin. Sna himthosca a bhí romhainn ba inmholta é an barrachas €6,817. Léirigh ár gClár Comhardaithe ag 31 Nollaig 2010 staid shásúil.

Maireann Gaisce ar an tacaíocht ó oibrithe deonacha agus tá líon mór díobh a thugann é dúinn. Tá suas le 1,000 Ceannaire Ghradam an Uachtaráin (PALanna) a thugann tacaíocht do gach rannpháirtí atá againn ar bhonn deonach. Gan a gcuid cúnaimh ní mhairfeadh an clár. Tá ríthábhacht leis an gcúnamh a fhaighimid ónár gComhaltaí Comhairleacha agus ó thacadóirí eile. Is mian liom buíochas ar leith a ghabháil lenár gComhairle a thugann a gcuid ama agus a scileanna dúinn chomh flaithiúlach sin. Agus is mian liom freisin buíochas mór a ghabháil lenár bhfoireann tiomanta faoi cheannas ár bPríomhfheidhmeannaigh Barney Callaghan agus a fhaigheann tacaíocht ónár Stiúrthóir Forbartha, John T. Murphy.

Beidh athrú mór i saol Gaisce le linn na bliana seo. An rud is tábhachtaí ná go mbeidh an dara téarma mar Uachtarán curtha i gcrích ag an Uachtarán Mhic Ghiolla Íosa agus beidh sí ag éirí as mar Phátrún Gaisce. Tá buíochas ar leith le dul don Uachtarán agus don Dr. Martin Mac Giolla Íosa, agus níl in ann na focail a aimsiú le cur síos a dhéanamh ar an gcaoi a bhfuil Gaisce chomh buíoch díobh. Bhí an t-ionchur a rinne siad chomh luachmhar sin. Spreag an bheirt agaibh sinn agus thug sibh misneach dúinn i líon mór bealaí éagsúla. Tríd an obair seo bhí tionchar mór ag an mbeirt agaibh orainn agus chuir sibh feabhas ar shaol na ndaoine óga.

Beidh téarma oifige na Comhairle reatha ag teacht chun deiridh i mbliana. Ba phríbhléid é dom a bheith ag obair le grúpa daoine a bhfuil buanna ar leith acu agus atá an-spéisiúil. Is féidir leat a bheith cinnte de go bhfuil feabhas mór ar Gaisce anois mar gheall ar na hiarrachtaí a rinne líon mór daoine agus iad chomh flaithiúlach faoi.

further reduce the grant by €63,454. To partially offset these reductions we had to make our first increase in eleven years in participant fees. Total expenditure for the year amounted to €1,090,839 an increase of €16,128 on the previous year. In the circumstances which faced us, the achievement of having a surplus of €6,817 was a very commendable result. Our Balance Sheet at 31st December 2010 shows a satisfactory situation.

Gaisce survives on the voluntary support given to us by so many. We have up to 1,000 President's Award Leaders (PALs) who support each of our participants on a voluntary basis. Without their help the programme would collapse. The assistance of our Advisory Members and other supporters is critical to us. Can I especially thank our Council who give of their time and skills so generously. Can I also extend our great thanks to our most dedicated staff so ably led by our Chief Executive Barney Callaghan and supported by our Director of Development, John T. Murphy.

This year marks a very significant change in the life of Gaisce. By far the most important of these is that President McAleese will have completed her second term in office and so will be retiring as our Patron. I could not find words to describe adequately the enormous gratitude Gaisce owes to the President and Dr. Martin McAleese whose contributions have been so valuable. We have been inspired and encouraged in so many ways by both of you. Through this you have been key influencers in changing for the better the lives of our young people.

This year also will see the end of the current Council's term of office. It has been a privilege for me to work with such a talented and interesting group of people. You can rest assured that Gaisce is better because of the efforts of so many given so generously.

# Tuairisc an Phríomhfheidhmeannaigh

Clúdaíonn an Tuarascáil Bhliantúil seo an bhliain ina raibh comóradh cúig bliana fichead ag Gaisce. Le linn na buaicbhliana tábhachtaí seo chláraigh 17,262 rannpháirtí nua do na Gradaim Cré-Umha, Airgid agus Óir agus bronnadh 9,361 Gradam ag searmanais Gradaim ar fud an oileáin: 8,281 Gradam Cré-Umha, 986 Gradam Airgid agus 94 Gradam Óir. Is seo an bhliain i stair Gaisce ina raibh an leibhéal rannpháirtíochta is airde agus inar bronnadh an méid is mó Gradam. Thug líon mór daoine mór-le-rá i saol na hÉireann ar fud an oileáin a gcuid ama go flaithiúlach chun Gradaim a bhronnadh ar dhaoine óga agus aitheantas a thabhairt dá gcuid iarrachtaí.

Le comóradh an Iubhaile Cúig Bliana Fichead ag An Post agus ag Banc Ceannais na hÉireann tugadh aitheantas suntasach don fhreastal cúig bliana fichead a rinneadh chun forbairt a dhéanamh ar fhorbairt phearsanta na ndaoine óga ar oileán na hÉireann. Ba dhóigh oiriúnach é an tábhacht a bhí ann chun bonn nua Uí Irighile a bhronnadh mar aitheantas ar an tseirbhís a soláthraíodh do Gaisce leis an bPátrún bunaidh an Dr. Pádraig Ó hRíghile a cheiliúradh. Le linn na bliana bhronn an tUachtarán Mhic Ghiolla Íosa bonn Uí Irighle ar chúigear a sholáthar an tseirbhís is faide do Gaisce.

Sa bhliain seo nuair a thug ár bPátrún tacaíocht mhór agus aitheantas suntasach do Gaisce, d'éirigh linn ardleibhéal aitheantais a bhaint amach. Bhí Alumni Gaisce, Tar Éis Óir (TÉÓ) lárnach don obair agus do na ceiliúrthaí a rinneamar i rith na bliana agus bhí líon mór ball TÉÓ, sealbhóirí Gradaim Óir agus Gradaim eile gníomhach agus iad ag tacú le Gaisce. Cosúil leis na blianta roimhe seo bhí sealbhóirí Ghradaim Gaisce rannpháirteach in imeachtaí ar fud na hEorpa agus bhí imeacht tríthaobhach i mBaile Átha Cliath agus i gCiarraí a reáchtáil TÉÓ agus ag deireadh an imeachta bhí fáiltiú inár gCeanncheathrú nua i dTeach Ráth an tSraith inar fhreastail baill den Chór Taidhleoireachta.

Agus an gaol atá againn leis an nGradam *Duke of Edinburgh* (DofE) i dTuaisceart Éireann ag fás agus ag forbairt bhí comhshearmanas Gradaim ar siúl i dTuaisceart Éireann áit ar bronnadh Gradaim DofE agus Gaisce. Thug Ard-Rúnaí Chumann Idirnáisiúnta na nGradam den *Duke of Edinburgh* cuairt ar Gaisce chomh maith le toscaireacht ó Údarás na nGradam sa Rómáin atá ag teacht chun cinn.

Táim fíorbhuíoch den tacaíocht leanúnach a thagann ón Roinn Leanaí agus Gnóthaí Óige agus ónár gcomhaltaí Comhairleacha agus ó dhaoine/ghrúpaí eile a thugann tacaíocht dúinn, atá luaite ar leathanach 16. Bhí na tionscail Rásaíocht Chapall agus Beostoc an-ghníomhach agus thug siad tacaíocht airgeadais do Gaisce agus d'éirigh leo an Gradam a chur ag feidhmiú ina dtionscail.

## Chief Executive's Report

This Annual Report covers the year in which Gaisce celebrated its Silver Jubilee. In this important milestone year 17,262 new participants registered for Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards and at Award ceremonies throughout the island 9,361 Awards were presented: 8,281 Bronze, 986 Silver and 94 Gold. This marks the highest level of participation and Awards presented in any one year in Gaisce's history. Across the island many people, prominent in Irish life, generously gave of their time to present Awards to young people and acknowledge their efforts.

The marking of the Silver Jubilee by An Post and the Central Bank of Ireland was a significant recognition of a quarter of a century of service to the personal development of young people on the island of Ireland. The striking of the new Hillery medal acknowledging service to Gaisce was a fitting way to celebrate our founding Patron, Dr. Patrick J. Hillery. Five of the longest serving Gaisce people were presented with the Hillery medal by President McAleese during the year.

In a year which saw significant support and recognition from our Patron President McAleese; Gaisce's profile across Ireland reached a significant level of recognition. Gaisce's Alumni, Tar Éis Óir (TÉÓ), were central to our work and celebrations throughout the year and many TÉÓ members, Gold Award and other Award holders were active in support of Gaisce. As in previous years, Gaisce Award holders participated in international events across Europe and TÉÓ hosted a tri-lateral event in Dublin and Kerry which culminated in a reception in our newly occupied HQ at Ratra House with members of the Diplomatic Corps.

As our relationship with the Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) in Northern Ireland continues to grow and develop a joint Award ceremony took place in Northern Ireland where DofE and Gaisce Awards were presented. The Secretary General of the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Association visited Gaisce as did a delegation from the emerging Award Authority in Romania.

I gratefully acknowledge the ongoing support of the Department of Children and Youth Affairs and our Advisory members and other supporters who are highlighted on page 16. The Horseracing and Bloodstock industries were particularly proactive and successful in supporting Gaisce financially and in getting the Award operating within their industries.

Don chuid is mó den chúig bliana fichead bhí Óglaigh na hÉireann gníomhach trí thacaíocht a thabhairt do Gaisce. Ba thaitní ar leith é dúshlán an turais eachtraigh bhliantúil a d'eagraigh an zú Reisimint Airtléire Machaire d'fhiche naoi duine óg. Ba le brón mór a chualamar faoi bhás Leifteanantghinearál Dermot Earley – a bhí ina thacadóir mór do Gaisce. Guímid gach rath ar Leifteanantghinearál Seán McCann agus é mar Cheann Foirne d'Óglaigh na hÉireann. D'imigh Fachtna Murphy, a bhí ina thacadóir mór do Gaisce ar feadh tréimhse fada, ar scor mar Choimisinéir na nGardaí agus guímid gach rath ar Martin Callinan a tháinig ina áit.

Braitheann Gaisce, mar chláir forbartha pearsanta do dhaoine óga, go hiomlán ar an obair agus ar iarrachtaí Cheannairí Ghradam an Uachtaráin (PALanna) a oibríonn go deonach. Táimid an-bhuíoch díobh as an ionchur suntasach a dhéanann siad agus ár sochaí á forbairt agus bhí ríméad orainn nuair a bhronn an tUachtarán Gradaim Fiúntais Cathrach ar 67 PAL in 2010. Foilsítear príomhdhoiciméid Gaisce i nGaeilge agus i mBéarla.

Bhí ár bPátrún a thugann an-spreagadh dúinn, an tUachtarán Máire Mhic Ghiolla Íosa lárnach do na ceiliúrthaí lubhaile Cúig Bliana Fichead a rinneamar agus gabhaimid buíochas ar leith léi agus lena fear céile an Dr. Martin Mac Giolla Íosa don cheannasaíocht a thaispeáin siad agus don chaoi ar fhreastail siad ar Gaisce.

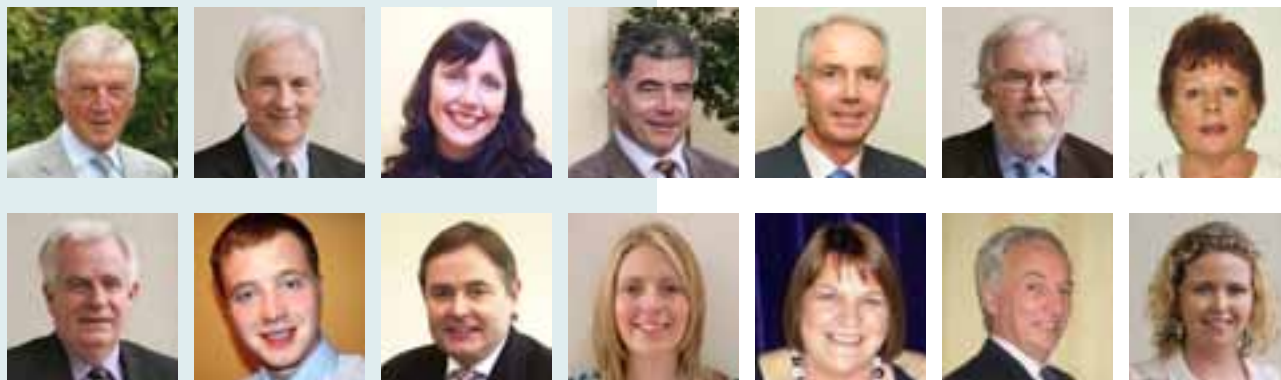

The President's hope that as many young people as possible might avail of the opportunities provided by the Award has been responded to across Northern Ireland by PALS in schools and youth organisations working with support from our Development Officers, statutory and voluntary bodies and our colleagues at the Duke of Edinburgh's Award office.

This co-operation ensured the success of the second Joint Award Presentation Ceremony held in Cookstown, Co. Tyrone on 10 September 2010. There was a wonderful turn out of Bronze and Silver Award recipients – more than 150 attended with their parents and PALS. Our thanks are due to Keith Crossan, a former Irish International Rugby star, who was the inspirational guest speaker.

Numbers have increased during the past year with growing levels of participation in all of the Northern counties. There has also been continued growth in the Crossing Bridges Programme, which has been supported by the International Fund for Ireland. Tá líonra sóisialta agus gairmiúil ag TÉÓ do theaghlach an Ghradaim i gcoitinne, rannpháirtithe, agus cairde den Ghradam san áireamh. In 2010, d'fhorbair TÉÓ réimse a ghníomhaíochtaí, cothaíodh naisc idirnáisiúnta, leathnaíodh na féidearthachtaí agus an oiliúint amach anseo chomh maith leis na féidearthachtaí forbartha pearsanta dá bhaill, agus ag an am céanna lean sé ar aghaidh ag tacú le scéim an ghradaim in Éirinn.

I measc na mbuaicphointí le linn na bliana bhí an turas 'Discovering Ireland', tionscadal spreagúil, uileghabhálach, tríthaobhach agus pan-Eorpach a bhí faoi cheannas Tar Éis Óir i mí Iúil nuair a tháinig tuairim is 30 duine óg le chéile as an tSlóivéin, Poblacht na Seice agus Éirinn i réigiún Pháirc Náisiúnta Chill Airne. Fuair eamar tacaíocht airgeadais shuntasach don tionscadal seo ó Chlár Choimisiún na hEorpa don Aos Óg i mBun Gníomhaíochta. Príomhthéamaí an tionscadail ba ea cúrsaí oideachais trí ghníomhaíochtaí amuigh faoin aer agus trí shaoránacht Eorpach. Bunaíodh na gníomhaíochtaí uile ar na príonsabail seo. D'eascair an turas as na turais gradaim dhéthaobhacha a bhí ann roimhe seo idir an tSlóivéin, Poblacht na Seice agus Éirinn, agus is bealach é le tionscadail níos mó cosúil leis seo a chur ar bun amach anseo. Na ceannairí ar fad ba ea Ceannairí Ghradam an Uachtaráin agus Ceannairí Sléibhe i gcúrsaí oiliúna. Mar aitheantas do thábhacht agus luach na hócáide, scríobh an tUachtarán Mhic Ghiolla Íosa litir le heagraithe agus rannpháirtithe an tionscadail a thréaslú agus leis na hiarrachtaí grúpa agus pearsanta a rinne siad a mholadh. Tar Éis Óir is the Irish Award Holders Association, made up of voluntary members who have completed one of the Gaisce Awards. TÉÓ maintains a social and professional network for the wider award family including participants and friends of the award. Through its activities, TÉÓ inspires its members to dream more, learn more, do more and become more...

TÉÓ's objectives are to:

- Support the President's Award in the further development of the Award programme.
- Provide a forum for the views of Award holders on Award related matters to be shared with Council.
- Encourage Award holders to become Award Leaders.
- Establish links with award holders internationally.
- Provide members with social and other activities for their continued personal development.

In 2010, TÉÓ expanded its scope of activity, fostered its international links, broadened horizons and future training and personal development possibilities for its members, while continuing to support the award scheme in Ireland.

Highlights of the year included the 'Discovering Ireland' expedition, an exciting, inclusive, tri-lateral, pan-European project led by Tar Éis Óir in July which brought together approximately 30 young people from Slovenia, Czech Republic and Ireland in the Killarney National Park region and for which we received significant financial support from the European Commission's Youth in Action programme. The main themes of the project were education through outdoor activities and European citizenship. All activities were rooted in these principles. The expedition was a follow-up to previous bi-lateral award expeditions between Slovenia, Czech Republic and Ireland, and is paving the way for larger scale similar projects in the future. All expedition leaders were President's Award Leaders and Mountain Leaders in training. Notably, in recognition of the importance and value of the event, President McAleese wrote a letter of congratulation to the organisers and participants of the project to commend their personal and group efforts. In addition, Irish Award Holders continue to represent Ireland at the highest levels internationally.

Steps have now been taken to develop an online facility and this will enable PALs who cannot attend a training programme to access the information they need to support them in their work with Award participants. Work on a MOODLE (Modular Object-Oriented Dynamic Learning Environment) interface for Gaisce is well under way.

The Quality Assurance Committee has been reviewing existing arrangements for ensuring quality of participant experience through the Award programme, with particular focus on the level of challenge individual young people set for themselves and the issue of personal safety. The Q.A. Committee has been looking at quality assurance provisions and advice offered by the Duke of Edinburgh's Award and the International Award Association, and commend the work done by Tar Éis Óir members Andrew Forde and Cian Timmons. A weekend training programme, offering advice on Venture management and safety in the delivery of the Award was provided at Ratra House by Cian Timmons.

The Committee has recommended that an evaluation process should be put in place at Gold level that would involve seeking feedback from 10% of participants on their experience of journeying towards Gold. This information will be invaluable to the Council and staff of the Award as they continue to develop and improve what is already an impressive Award programme.

Child protection is very important to us and we gratefully acknowledge the support given to Gaisce by the National Youth Council of Ireland (NYCI) with reviewing and updating our protection policy. Our work in this area has been focused on making our policy and its implementation more robust to reflect the times we live in.

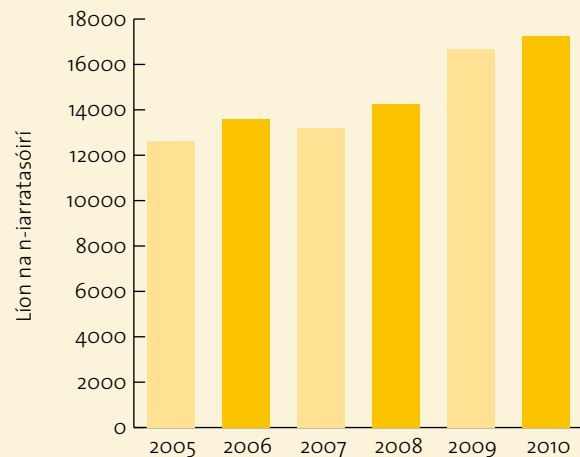

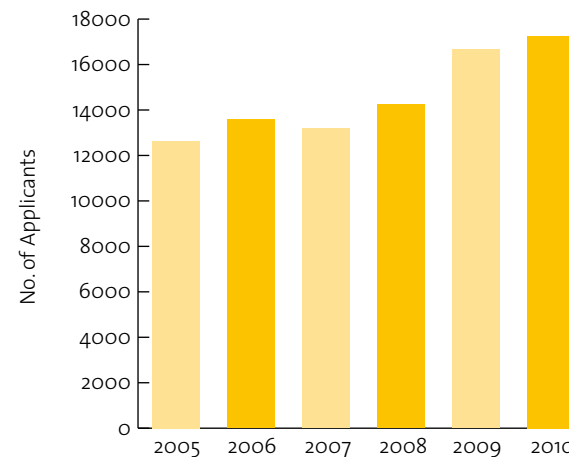

## Governance

Work on enhancing all aspects of Human Resource policy and procedure was progressed. Work commenced on the data base with a view to providing better management information in the future. A suite of Human Resource policies and a safety statement were prepared throughout the year. Work on improving Gaisce's operational efficiency and effectiveness progressed with the extension of the use of appropriate information communications technology. The Garda Vetting system put in place as part of Child Protection Policy is in full operation.

The Council's four committees, Human Resources, Northern Ireland, Finance and Quality continued to oversee the business of the organisation as follows:

During the year the committee met and made progress on the completion of an employee handbook. As part of this process an updated Gaisce Safety Statement and Staff Grievance Procedure were produced. At year end, the staff had been asked to appoint two staff reps who will liaise with the HR committee in relation to appropriate staff matters. The committee also looked at the PAL Garda Vetting and refereeing process and are conducting a PAL Audit which will lead to conclusions in this area. Correspondence from the Department of Health and Children relating to employees salaries was also dealt with. Procedures were put in place to cater for any future staff appointments or renewal of staff contracts whenever they arose.

### Finance Committee

The Finance committee had Pre and Post Audit meetings with the auditors Pricewaterhouse Coopers. They reviewed the audited accounts and recommended them to Council for signing. The committee ensured that management accounts were brought before each meeting of Council during the year. On behalf of the committee, the executive met with the officials of the Department of Health & Children to conclude the annual grant. A special consultative Forum for Advisory Members was held in Farmleigh House to listen to the views of funders on Gaisce's direction and to thank them for their ongoing support.




