Residential Project

Since 1 September 2008 a residential project became part of the requirements for the **Gold Award**.

Aim

To broaden experience through involvement with others in a residential setting.

Ethos

The project gives participants a shared purposeful experience with people who are not their usual companions, working towards a common goal. It should be an experience that broadens the participant's outlook and horizons.

Action

This is only required at Gold Award level

Participants are required to undertake a shared purposeful activity, with people who are not their usual colleagues or friends, in an unfamiliar residential setting.

Time Period

The activity should take place over a period of at least four nights and five consecutive days. In exceptional circumstances, the commitment may be spread over two weekends. In these circumstances, the same activity must be pursued over both weekends and must take place within the same 12 month period.

Please note that this is only required at Gold level and only applies to registrations for the Gold Award after 1 September 2008
